CAN I APPLY?

Eligibility

- Member of St. Olaf Lutheran Church
- Be enrolled in a college, university, technical institution or seminary for educational purposes
- Be involved in church life
- Demonstrate academic competence by maintaining a cumulative 2.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale (or equivalent on other scales)

Application Evaluation Rubric

- All materials submitted by deadline & completed
- Scored on service (45%), school (35%) & academics (20%)
