Addendum / follow up after meeting

- Medical Missions: after the meeting there was more discussion about how the \$1000. (\$500 from the Mission Fund and \$500 from Women of Grace) would be distributed. After the meeting the idea was to split it. A following email indicated that it should all go to Medical Missions for expenses. Then we were asked to split it. The final decision was that the money will be split, ½ to Medical Missions for expenses and ½ to Peggy for travel expenses. A yearly donation was not approved, per the minutes. It will be voted on each year.
- Coating parking lot and parsonage drive: after the meeting it was assumed that the coating was approved with JAC. Jerry approved the quote and work proceeded. However, this project was not approved at the meeting (see minutes above). After finding out, and after the fact, an email vote was done and the coating was unanimously approved. Also, JAC wanted payment right after completing the project. This was not considered. However, John was contacted and payment was made. This project is complete.
