

# From Pastor Tom:



Who are the people in your life who simply give joyfully, cheerfully? Some of you may have picked up on this, but I like to golf .

Oftentimes, when we are on the course, those I golf with will cheerfully offer to buy me a drink from the Drink Cart. I'm touched by the gesture. It sounds simple, not a big deal, but it touches me. You could say it matters to me.

I remember when Kris and I were just starting out in our marriage, we had only one income, just bought our first house, and started having children. We were a little tight. My parents gifted us children at Christmastime. We were able to save that and grow it over time to now nearly 30 years later, it has grown substantially. Compounded over time, the yearly gift became even more abundant. Yes, we were blessed.

I'm seeing this in our church. Year after year, many of our families cheerfully give to the General Fund (supports our Ministry Plan, staff salaries, utilities+) and because of your faithful giving, we remain a healthy, even thriving congregation. Several households give cheerfully to the Mission Fund (that invests in a whole array of local, city, state, national and worldwide missions that St. Olaf has a personal connection to). Finally, several households recognize that this whole campus and building is OURS



TOGETHER. So, to maintain it and make sure it looks beautiful, we contribute joyfully a portion of what God has given us, to make improvements (like new flooring in our sanctuary, new siding outside, and refreshed parking lot and more!).

Over the years (now in my 10<sup>th</sup> year at St. Olaf), I really notice those who LIVE GENEROUSLY and give cheerfully to God's Mission through His church called St. Olaf. We are so very blessed by such giving. As several churches near us are at a crossroads of declining worship attendance, shortage in offerings, lacking younger generations in worship attendance and decreasing membership, St. Olaf shows signs of increased vitality. Thank you everyone for worshipping here, serving in Jesus' name, and giving cheerfully...all signs of a lifestyle of Living Generously.



# **Lutefisk Dinner/Bake Sale/Scandi Butik**


